DAY 1

Arrive in French Polynesia

DAY 2

20 Nautical miles

Tahiti to Moorea

Travel west and discover what makes Moorea a haven of wild beauty. With eight dramatic mountain peaks, including a dormant volcano, Moorea is truly a sight to behold. To experience its full charm, step ashore and venture inland, where cascading waterfalls, glassy lagoons, and jungle trails await.

The island offers a variety of dining options, many featuring stunning views. Overwater bungalows perched above crystal-clear lagoons provide the perfect setting to enjoy a meal while watching the vibrant marine life swim below.



DAY 3

80 Nautical Miles

Moorea to Huahine

Known as the “Garden Island,” this idyllic destination is home to lush jungles and smooth, white-sand beaches. Rich with watermelon groves and coconut fields, Huahine is a true Eden, bursting with vibrant blooms and delicious plantations. Much of its authentic Polynesian charm remains untouched, offering visitors pristine waters and long stretches of unspoiled beach to enjoy. Paddle a kayak through secluded lagoons and gentle streams, or dive beneath the surface to swim among kaleidoscopic fish. A nearby sandbar emerges only at low tide, and with the flexibility of a private yacht charter, it’s yours to explore with ease.





DAY 4

40 Nautical Miles

Huahine to Raiatea

An island steeped in history, this peaceful oasis is a place of pilgrimage for many across the South Pacific. With a name that means “faraway heaven,” Raiatea enchants visitors with its serene lagoon and vibrant coral gardens just offshore. Towering mountains, often crowned with misty clouds, watch over the coastline, while sacred temples and ancient statues lie nestled in their foothills. At the northern tip of the island, enjoy a hands-on educational experience at a local pearl farm, where you can take home a prized Tahitian black pearl as a unique souvenir. End your day with a delicious meal on land, featuring freshly caught fish and refined French fusion cuisine.



DAY 5



20 Nautical Miles

Raiatea to Taha'a

Sharing its translucent lagoon with neighboring Raiatea, the so-called "Vanilla Island" is a hidden gem worth exploring. Step onto the powder-soft sands of Taha'a and breathe in the rich, sweet aroma of vanilla that lingers in the air. As the primary producer of vanilla orchids in French Polynesia, Taha'a weaves this prized ingredient into everything from oils to baked goods, making it a must-have souvenir. The coral reef that surrounds Raiatea also stretches to Taha'a, but here, the shallower waters invite you to swim alongside vibrant marine life thriving in the lagoon's embrace.

DAY 6

20 Nautical Miles

Taha'a to Bora Bora

Bora Bora, a postcard-perfect tropical paradise, is rightly known as the jewel of French Polynesia. Fall in love with this enchanting destination, your final stop on the charter. Powdery ivory beaches stretch along the coastline, while a large barrier reef promises unforgettable snorkeling adventures. The island's iconic lagoon invites you to float in glassy, turquoise waters and savor the ultimate sense of blissful relaxation. For more excitement, visit a dedicated spot where you can safely feed sharks and stingrays up close. Helicopter tours offer a breathtaking bird's-eye view of the island's dramatic beauty, and the dining scene is as refined as it is scenic, with options for exquisite cuisine by the sea.





Bora Bora

Wake up in the mystical, mythical Bora Bora, an island celebrated for its breathtaking scenery, romance, and a brilliant blue lagoon and reef often considered among the most beautiful in the world. Start your day soaking in the view from the sundeck of your yacht charter, then prepare to explore the mesmerizing underwater world. Bora Bora's marine life is truly captivating, with its central lagoon famed as a premier dive site featuring a variety of sharks, rays, and vibrant tropical fish.

If snorkeling or diving isn't for you, drop anchor at one of the island's many sandy cays. Perfect for sun-seekers, these peaceful spots are ideal for unwinding with loved ones and listening to the gentle hush of the surrounding waves.
